» Attacks leave animals with horrific injuries and often result in an agonising death

» Any dog has the ability to worry livestock, no matter how well trained you think it is

STOP & THINK

» Livestock worrying is a criminal offence

» Chasing and biting by dogs can cause pregnant sheep to have a miscarriage and young lambs to be separated from their mothers



» Under The Animals Act, if a dog is caught by a landowner in the act of worrying livestock, the dog may be shot

» As the owner you may be liable to prosecution and subject to a fine; the courts have the power to place a control or destruction order on your dog



**Do not run the risk -
