- >> Attacks leave animals with horrific injuries and often result in an agonising death
- >> Any dog has the ability to worry livestock, no matter how well trained you think it is

STOP&THINK

- >> Livestock worrying is a criminal offence
- >> Chasing and biting by dogs can cause pregnant sheep to have a miscarriage and young lambs to be separated from their mothers



- >> Under The Animals Act, if a dog is caught by a landowner in the act of worrying livestock, the dog may be shot
- As the owner you may be liable to prosecution and subject to a fine; the courts have the power to place a control or destruction order on your dog



Do not run the risk always keep your dog on a lead around sheep
